Suffield Public Schools is proud to announce a collaborative partnership with Community Health Resources (CHR). CHR is a comprehensive mental health provider in our region offering a range of services including individual and family therapy.

CHR will begin offering clinical services at both Suffield Middle School and Suffield High School starting on May 18th. Families are encouraged to reach out to CHR directly to schedule appointments at the telephone number listed on the attached flyer. Please note that the services CHR provides will be paid for in coordination with the family's insurance provider and coverage plan. Once families have gone through the application process with CHR, the student will be allowed release time from their class to go to scheduled therapy sessions. Initially there will be a limited number of slots available at each school, but as requests for therapy increase, CHR will work to meet this need by expanding on their time in our district.
