On Wednesday, February 28th, students and faculty over the age of 17 will be able to donate blood during the school day.

If interested, please sign up to donate at the table during any of the three lunch waves or in the office at any time.

When you sign up, you will be given a reminder card and pass. In addition, you will be given a consent form. You will not be allowed to sign up without taking this form. The form must be signed by the student, parent, and period 1, 3, 5, and 7 teachers and returned by February 23rd to an NHS member. This form is required to be completed and signed by all of the aforementioned individuals even if the student is 18 years old or older.
